## Saturn Ingress Into Sagittarius

Saturn ingresses or moves into the sign of Sagittarius on December 23, 2014, where he will take his time and not leave Sagittarius until December 2017. Typically, Saturn spends 2 and ½ years in each sign, but, for a variety of reasons, he will remain in Sagittarius for 3 years, which will give us plenty of time to listen to his messages and embrace the wisdom he will offer us!



The Sign of Sagittarius

The ingress of Saturn into Sagittarius has a theme that will be present for the entire 3 year period, this is the meaning of Saturn in Sagittarius that we will discuss. However, additionally, for the first 8 to 9 months, there is a unique and exciting formation that provides unique opportunities: The Grand Fire Trine of The Three Kings.

Right now, for the last month or so and until December 23, 2014, many of us are feeling Saturn moving through the last degrees of Scorpio. When Saturn culminates his time in any sign, there is a finishing up, a completion of the themes of the past few years. If you are feeling the intensity of Saturn's final weeks in Scorpio, this is the

time when what you have learned in the past two plus years is coming to a conclusion. As we wrote when Saturn first moved into Scorpio, the truth heals. With the remaining few weeks with Saturn in Scorpio, this is the time to trust what you have learned about your deepest wounds so that you can choose to move beyond them and heal.

### Saturn - the Birth Chart and Transits - Background

Natal Saturn (meaning, Saturn in our birth chart) is known as the Lord of Karma. Where he is placed in our birth chart relates to the blockages we face, particularly early in life. While he is not really trying to be a bad guy, he often appears to be as he attempts to remind us of our unfinished karma. In this regard, Saturn is viewed as a malefic planet. His intention is for us to realize that

we have the capacity to become the architect of our life, the author of our manuscript - to become our own authority! Saturn understands the concept of karma as a foundation from which we build our life (versus fate that we are subject to).

Transiting Saturn reflects the ongoing development of our efforts to finish up our unfinished karma and take control of our lives. In his role as the Enforcer of the zodiac, Saturn tests our efforts and is known for bringing difficulty and blockages into our life when our efforts as the architect or author have been ineffective. In his role as Uncle Saturn, which is his more supportive role than the Enforcer, Saturn reminds that we have the capacity to build the structures that will support our efforts.

***You could say that Saturn gives us the homework to do the work that allows us to write the next chapter of life.***

### **Saturn In Sagittarius - 3 Years**

The sign of Sagittarius contains the qualities of inspiration, vision, and truth. Sagittarius also brings an awareness of how our vision for life can guide us forward. Sagittarius is a forward looking, future oriented energy, like the arrow that flies into the world that lies in front of us. Alternatively, Saturn is a builder (he generally does not inspire us like Sagittarius). He is concerned with the physical reality of the structures in our lives (meaning bringing our Sagittarian vision into reality). He is concerned with the present (not the future like Sagittarius).



**So, when transiting Saturn is in Sagittarius, Saturn embraces Sagittarius' inspiration for the future and wants us to get to work building the structures that allow us to bring our vision into reality.**

***You could say that the motto for Saturn in Sagittarius is "Building the Future, One Brick at a Time".***


This motto has two elements, both of which need to be embraced:

- First, we need to have a vision for the future, and
- Second, we need to work one step at a time to bring that vision into reality.

**First**, we are meant to know our guiding philosophy, our truth, our direction in life that leads us to fulfilling our birth chart. If you are clear about your personal philosophy and direction, great! If you are not sure, or if you have doubts, Saturn in Sagittarius is a great time to reflect on this topic and to build that philosophy. Therefore, quiet reflection is one of the best uses of Saturn's energy. Saturn is actually a very patient planet when we listen to him. He is patient when we take the time to observe our vision, the reality of our current situation and what the next steps to move forward might be. But, if we do not do this, then he might test us in an effort to push us.

What do we mean by guiding philosophy? Our guiding philosophy is often summarized in statements we make like 'I see the world in these terms....' or 'I am guided each day by...'. Statements that summarize how we view the world, energy, spirit, love, nature, truth. Or, as Sappho says, 'I believe in having a simple home and living an uncomplicated life'. Then, as I say, 'Know Thyself and Shine'. What is your guiding philosophy?

Reflection is also connected with the winter season and a time when the external world slows down giving us time for reflection. Winter is a great time to sit in front of a fireplace with a glass of wine or a cup of tea and allow yourself the time to immerse yourself in a space of quiet. Saturn will move into Sagittarius on the heels of the Winter Solstice.

For Saturn, reflection comes best when we can forget about our To-Do lists for a while. In our home, we do not have a fireplace, but have found a few YouTube videos of a fireplace that are actually quite relaxing. Remember, this is not a To Do List, this is pure contemplation, which is often not a logical process as it needs room to expand and wander. Take time and let that happen.

**Second**, once you have greater clarity about your philosophy and vision for the future, then it is time to take the next step by building one brick at a time. Remember, this is a 3 year transit and you have plenty of time to move one brick at a time. But, we must take real action. The building process is about bringing your vision into reality. Here, Saturn can truly be your friend. When we have a vision, a goal, we often find that there are more than a few steps that need to be accomplished before our vision becomes reality. Uncle Saturn in Sagittarius says, "No Problem!" The vision of Sagittarius simply needs a plan and a one step at a time process that leads to achieving your goal. Remember, the Sagittarian vision is in the future, while Saturn is concerned with what you can do to support that vision in the present!

A key to understanding Saturn is that he is never in a hurry. In this regard, Saturn is also known as the Lord of Time. What does Saturn want? He wants to see us

making persistent, practical effort to bring our plan into reality.

Saturn Revealing Truth

Because Saturn also has a role of revealing the truth, sometimes we find that the truth is disappointing. So, early on with his ingress in to Sagittarius, this might take place - disappointment. The transits of Saturn are likely to identify one of two potential problems.

First, sometimes we find that the real world does not work exactly the way we have envisioned it. If you have this experience, Saturn does not want you to feel bad or to be disillusioned. He simply wants you to recognize the way the real world works and then incorporate that into your plans.

Second, sometimes there is a part of the building process that has not been attended to. Even if our vision is valid, Saturn demands that we make the effort, one brick at a time, to bring our plan into reality. So, if there is a part of your plan that needs action to move forward, Saturn wants you to make the effort.

## First Year - Grand Fire Trine of the Three Kings

As Saturn enters the sign of Sagittarius, he will complete a Grand Fire Trine (by sign, but not exact by degree). Saturn in Sagittarius will be trine Uranus in Aries and Jupiter in Leo through early August 2015. The three fire signs share two qualities: inspiration and action. Returning to our motto for Saturn in Sagittarius, "Building the Future, One Brick at a Time", the qualities of inspiration and action will experience greater harmony with our building efforts during this first year than at other times.

The greater excitement with this Grand Fire Trine comes with the recognition that Jupiter, Saturn and Uranus represent the mythic lineage of the kings of the heavens in Roman myth. Uranus was the first king of heaven. He was overthrown by his son, Saturn, who was king of the titan gods. In turn, Saturn was overthrown by his son, Jupiter.

On his own, Saturn can play the role of Enforcer and introduce obstacles, limitations, blockages, and challenges. I often speak of the outer planets and their corresponding Greek and Roman Gods as not playing well together in the sandbox. But, with the harmonious nature of a trine, we find that The Three Kings will find it much easier to play nicely together. That is an encouraging notion!

With the three kings in a grand fire trine, while they have very different approaches to life, they are willing to work together, at least for a while. In working together, each will bring a quality that provides a perspective that is both unique and complimentary.

Together, these three kings will give us all a bit more confidence in ourselves and in our capacity to trust our individual gifts and the vision and plans that bring these gifts into reality.

### **Who is MOST Affected?**

Saturn's transit through Sagittarius takes place in each of our charts in a particular house. So, in this regard, we are each impacted. Additionally, over the next three years, transiting Saturn will make various aspects in all of our charts.

However, three groups of individuals come to mind that will experience important test of Saturn over the next three years. SO, those born:

- between November 22 and December 21, you will experience transiting Saturn conjunct the Sun
- between mid-November 1985 and early November 1988, will experience their First Saturn Return.
- between mid-January 1956 and early January 1959, will experience their Second Saturn Return.

All three of these transits can be considered among the most important tests of transiting Saturn.

A Transit Forecast identifies the important aspects Saturn will make in your birth chart, along with the particular test Saturn will bring and how you can recognize what he wants, so you can pass his tests.
